**The Law of Fixing Space: Geographies of Law and
Healing in Drug Treatment Court**

Dawn Moore is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Law, Carleton University. She is currently working on a 3 year SSHRC funded project that looks at the experiences of women in Drug Treatment Courts across the country. This project builds on her earlier work addressing the rise of addiction treatment in the criminal justice system. Dawn also has several side projects on the go including one on feminist criminology, a collaborative project with Aaron Doyle and Kevin Haggerty on the future of criminology in Canada and a piece on the shift in criminal justice language that renames offenders as 'clients'. Further, Dr. Moore is the managing editor of the Canadian Journal of Law and Society/Revue Canadienne du Droit et Soci t .
