Guest: **Dr. Mark Zeitoun, University of East Anglia (UK)**

Professor Zeitoun is a specialist in shared water resources and works particularly on the role of power relations pertaining to the potential of cooperation or conflicts. He co-directed the *London Water Research group* and co-founded the *UEA Water Security Research Center*.

Trained both in environmental engineering and in human geography, Dr. Zeitoun offers necessarily an interdisciplinary analytical perspective on that complex subject. He is the author namely of: *Power and water in the Middle-East: the Hidden Politics of the Palestinian-Israeli Water Conflict* (IB Tauris 2008).

During this discussion, we will be presenting the Global Campaign on the right to clean and accessible water in Palestine. This campaign will be taking place between December 6th and December 13th 2009. This is an initiative of the EWASH Advocacy Task Force, representative of thirty, or so, organizations, falling under the coordination of COHRE (Center on Housing Rights and Evictions).
